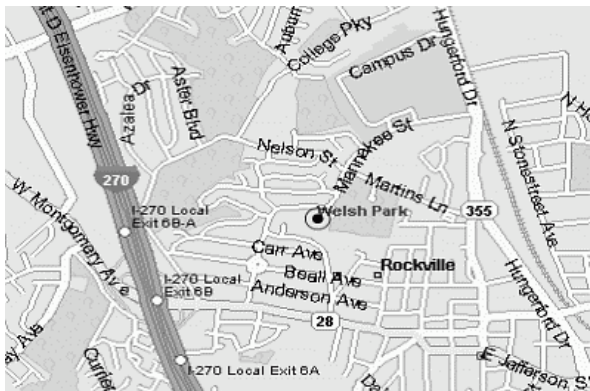


**Meeting Location:** Unitarian Universalist Church of Rockville. Rm 25 Bldg. 2, 1st bldg on left from main parking lot.  
501 Mannakee Street, Rockville, MD 20850

near cloverleaf of MD 28 and I-270  
near Montgomery College

Take I-270, exit 6, East onto MD Rt 28, 2nd Left onto Mannakee going North. Or, from downtown Rockville (Rt 355), West on W Montgomery Av (W Jefferson St/MD Rt 28), turning Right onto Mannakee. Go .5 mi North, do not look for church, look for church sign, turn into church driveway, park in lower lot.

From Rt. 355 (Rockville Pike) turn onto Mannakee street, go .5 miles SW, follow directions above.

Church is approx. 1.2 mi from Rockville Station on the Metro Red line.

Buses run from Rockville station to Montgomery College which is .2 mi from church. Go SW down Mannakee, Left at church sign and then into church driveway. Call Metro for schedules.

# If You're A Man In Maryland, You Need This!

## Our Goal

To improve the quality of life of children of separation and divorce, principally by assisting their fathers.

A man needs to become very familiar with potential judicial outcomes before becoming enmeshed in legal processes. Family Law proceedings in Maryland dealing with divorce, custody, and children's access to non-residential parents are very litigious.

## WE CAN HELP !!!

Our members assist each other in avoiding the pitfalls of the family litigation process. We can provide referrals to experienced lawyers highly skilled in family law.

We strongly support mutual decision making such as mediation, but if forced into litigation by unreasonable demands of the other party, we believe in fighting to achieve success.

Fathers United for Equal Rights Foundation Inc. (FUERF) is a nonprofit self-help support group for men and women who are concerned about fairness in the divorce process, and the related issues of custody, child support, visitation, alimony, property disposition, legal fees, and daycare.

## Problems With Access (Visitation)

Many custodial parents vilify the other parent to the extent that the children end up hating someone. This abuse destroys the child's relationship with the other parent, essentially robbing them of their youth.

This parental alienation is truly one of the most significant tragedies imposed on our children, no matter the age.

Our Meetings Provide:

- a forum for separating or divorced fathers to meet where people in the group can learn from each other's experiences.

- personalized comments are available from a highly competent family lawyer whose views will, in all likelihood, be far more pertinent to your case than the voluminous and often unfocused material on the Web.

- free legal clinics featuring lawyers who have been associated with FUERF for many years. They give on-the-spot answers to your questions. Bring your important legal documents with you to our meetings. Our members have had success with these lawyers even with the most difficult custody cases.

- opportunity to question different lawyers as they rotate through our schedule. Come to several meetings and then decide which one best meets your needs.

- referrals to family law counsel

- free brief initial consultation for our members.

- emergency telephone advice for problems that cannot wait until the next scheduled meeting. Dial 301-927-7638 to obtain the list of FUERF volunteer advisors.

- information on current divorce law and parenting issues.

- a bibliography of books and handouts for an array of topics and issues (how to formulate a parenting plan, mediation, etc.).

- liaison activities with the "Coalition of Separated and Divorced Self-Help Support Groups". The Coalition sponsors social functions. FUERF members are asked to volunteer to assist with these events.

- Coordination with the Children's Rights Counsel (CRC) and other groups to track legislation in Annapolis, Maryland that will improve the quality of life of children caught in the cross-fire of separating or divorced parents.

- trips to Annapolis to lend testimony for selected legislation that is important to families and has been reviewed by our FUERF lawyers.

- coordination and support with other groups that complement FUERF.
